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## Foreword

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The Kosovo Agency of Statistics (KAS) has started to release data on Kosovo's Import and Export since 2001, but as reliable data are considered from 2005.

Publication of Kosovo International Trade is based on data from Kosovo Customs Service.

All monthly releases are preliminary data that differ from annual (final) data. This release contains data according to the circulation of goods, statistical procedures, sections of the Standard international trade classification (SITC), sections according to the Harmonized System (HS) and partner countries. The methodology and methods are adapted to integrate and compare the statistics of international trade in goods at the international level.

Imports are presented according to country of origin, while exports according to destination.

Fig. 1: Exports of goods, 2005-2022

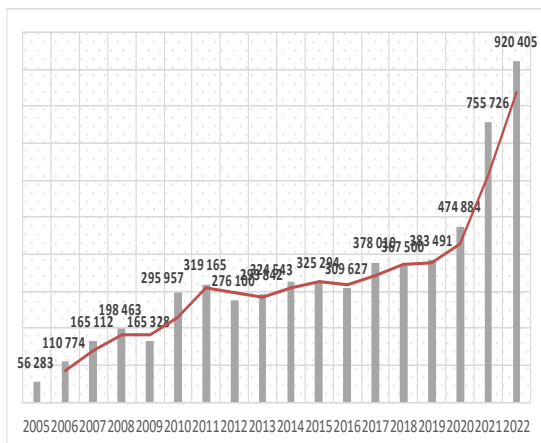
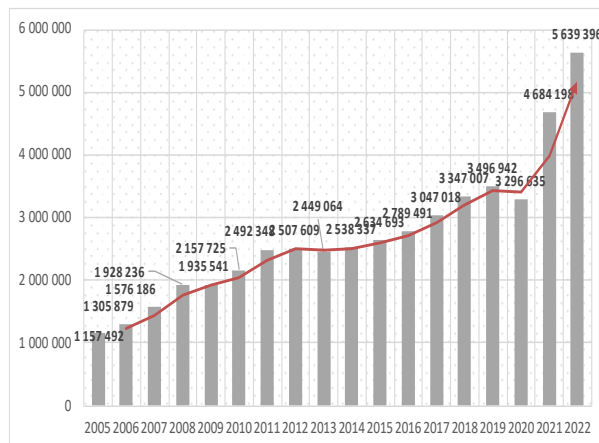


Fig. 2: Imports of goods, 2005-2022

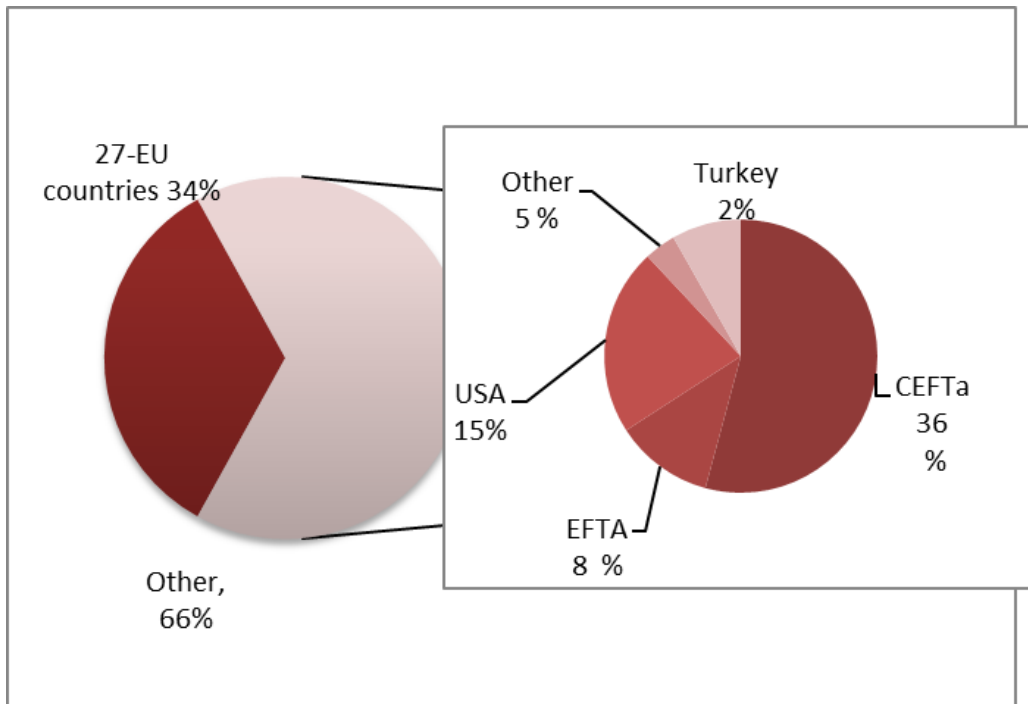

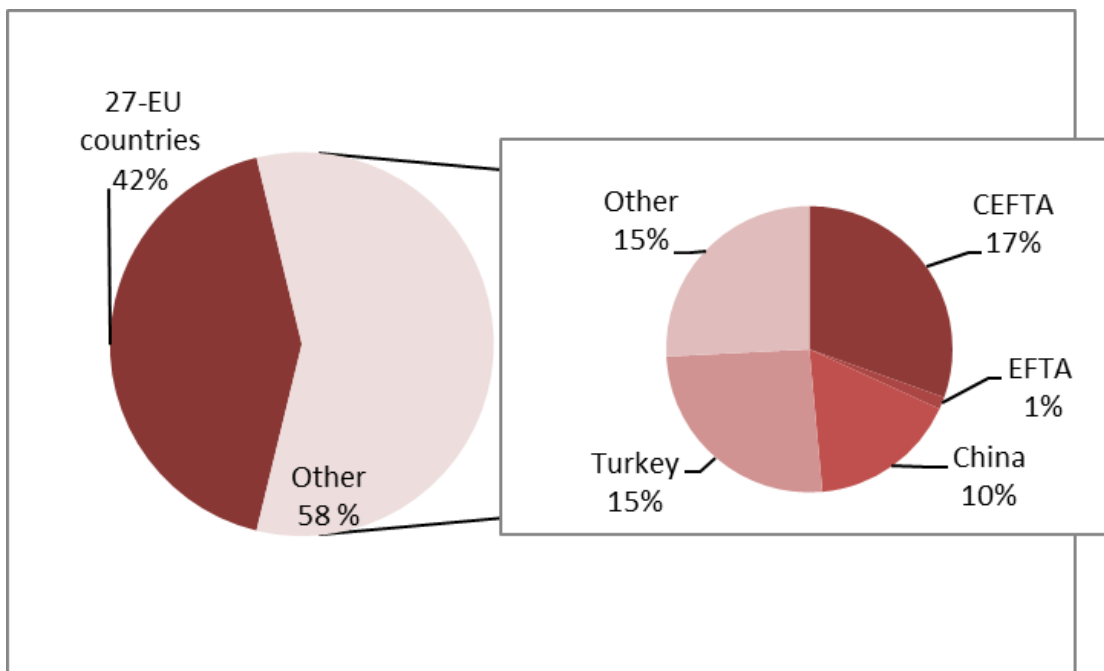

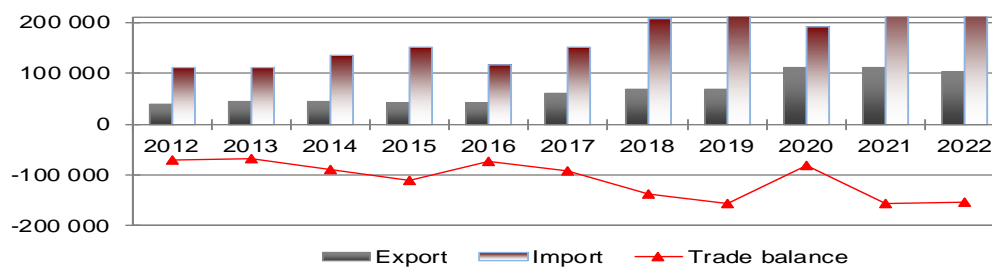

Fig. 11: Graphic presentation with Albania



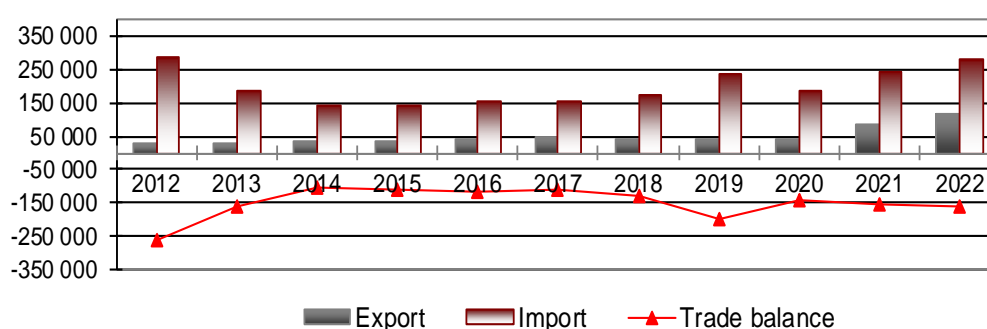

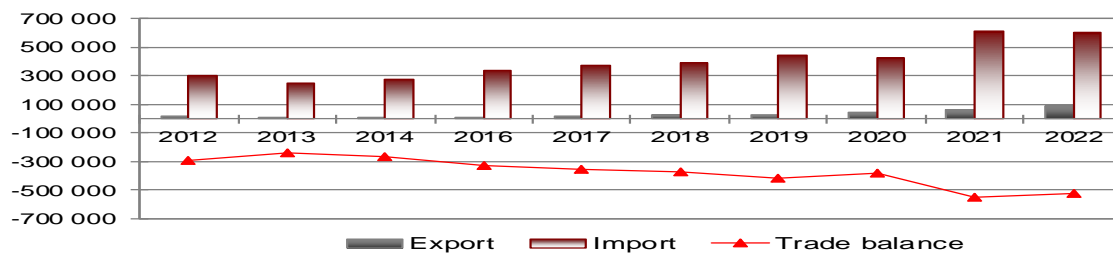
**Fig. 12: Graphic presentation with North Macedonia****Main products with North Macedonia**

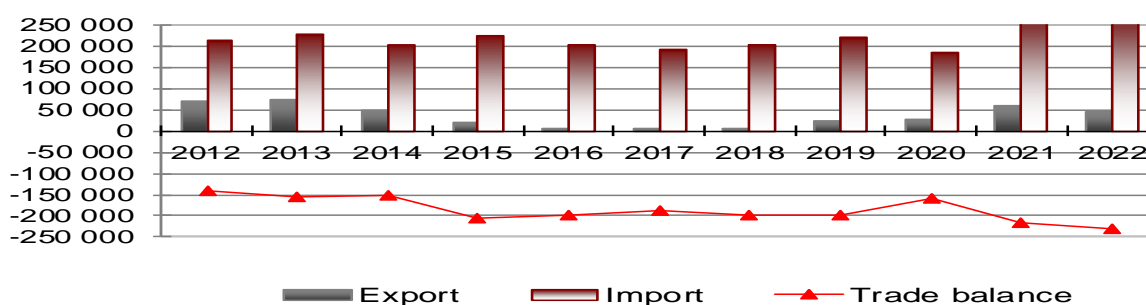

Fig. 14: Graphic presentation with Italy

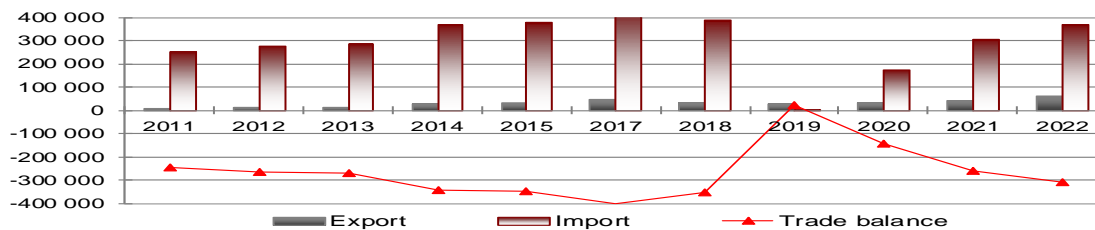

## Flow of export and import in 2022

In this publication of the statistics of trade in goods, many clarifications are provided in detail about what our country exports to the foreign market and what it imports from the foreign market.

The trade of goods in 2022 had a trade deficit in the amount of 4.7 billion Euros, which indicates a higher trade deficit (20.1%) compared to 2021, where we also have a negative balance this year. Total exports this year were 920.4 million Euros, while imports were 5.6 billion Euros. Export covers import for only 16.3%.

Comparing the export data for Kosovar goods during the year 2022 with that of the year 2021, the figures show that we have an annual increase of (21.8%), an increase which further affects the negative trade balance of Kosovo.

Exports, according to sections, this year had an increase in the following groups: various manufactured articles worth about 179.7 million Euros (compared to 156.8 million Euros or 19.5% of total exports with an increase of 14.6%), leather and articles thereof in the value of about 9.4 million Euros (compared to 7.7 million Euros or 1.0% of the total exports with an increase of 21.1%), wood and articles thereof in the value of about 15.6 million Euros (compared to 10.2 million Euros or 1.7% of total exports with an increase of 52.4%), articles of stone, plaster, ceramic and glass products worth about 30.4 million Euros (compared to 19.2 million Euros or 3.3% of total exports with an increase of 58.2%), mineral products worth about 104.0 million Euros (compared to 44.9 million Euros or 11.3% of total exports with an increase of 131.4%), textiles and articles thereof worth about 31.6 million Euros (compared to 25.7 million Euros or 3.4% of total exports with an increase of 22.6%), paper and articles thereof worth about 11.2 million Euros (compared to 7.6 million Euros or 1.2% of total exports with an increase of 47.9%), machinery, mechanical and electrical equipment worth about 30.8 million Euros (compared to 30.8 million Euros or 3.3% of total exports with an increase of 0.2%), plastics, rubber and articles thereof worth about 127.9 million Euros (compared to 80.4 million Euros or 13.9% of total exports with an increase of 59.0%), means of transport worth about 11.1 million Euros (compared to 7.3 million Euros or 1.2% of total exports with an increase of 53.3%), prepared foodstuff, beverages, alcoholic beverages and tobacco worth about 69.6 million Euros (compared to 57.7 million Euros or 7.6% of total exports with an increase of 20.5%), products of the chemical industry worth about 20.4 million Euros (compared to 17.6 million Euros or 2.3% of total exports with an increase of 15.9%).

During this period there was a decrease in exports in this group: basic metals and articles thereof in the value of about 212.7 million Euros (compared to 244.2 million Euros or 23.1% of the total exports with a decrease of 12.9%).

The positive trend of export growth from 2012-2022 is behind the following groups of sections: crops products from 14.4 million Euros to 33.3 million Euros, prepared foodstuffs, beverages, alcoholic beverages and tobacco from 16.1 million Euros to 69.6 million Euros, plastic, rubber and articles thereof from 14.0 million Euros to 127.9 million Euros, various manufactured articles from 2.5 million Euros to 179.7 million Euros, etc.

The trade in goods data for the Import of Kosovo in 2022 have recorded an annual increase of about (20.4%) compared to the previous year 2021.

Increases in imports according to sections were observed in the following groups: mineral products (fuels) worth about 1.0 billion Euros (compared to 629.3 million Euros or 18.5% of total imports with an increase of 66.1%), plastics, rubber and articles thereof in the value of about 384.2 million Euros (compared to 338.8 million Euros or 6.8% of total imports with an increase of 13.4%), base metals and articles thereof in the value of about 593.4 million Euros (compared to with 518.7 million Euros or 10.5% of the total imports with an increase of 14.4%), articles of stone, plaster, ceramic and glass products worth about 195.0 million Euros (compared to 162.8 million Euros or 3.5% of total imports with an increase of 19.8%), textiles and articles thereof worth about 267.1 million Euros (compared to 235, 8 million Euros or 4.7% of total imports with an increase of 13.3%), various manufactured items worth about 146.3 million Euros (compared to 126.4 million Euros or 2.6% of total imports with an increase of 15.7% ), machinery, mechanical and electrical equipment worth about 624.8 million Euros (compared to 598.1 million Euros or 11.81% of total imports with an increase of 4.4%), paper and articles thereof worth about 86,4 million Euros (compared to 63.8 million Euros or 1.5% of total imports with an increase of 35.5%), live animals, products of animal origin worth about 280.2 million Euros (compared to 198.6 million Euros or 5.0% of total imports with an increase of 41.1%), prepared foodstuffs, beverages, alcoholic beverages and tobacco worth about 653.1 million Euros (compared to 556.0 million Euros or 11.6% of total imports with an increase of 17.5%), wood and articles thereof

worth about 124.2 million Euros (compared to 105.3 million Euros or 2.2% of total imports with an increase of 18.0%), fats worth about 61.1 million Euros (compared to with 41.6 million Euros or 1.1% of total imports with an increase of 46.9%), footwear (shoes and parts of such articles) worth about 53.9 million Euros (compared to 44.7 million Euros or 1.0 % of total imports with an increase of 20.6%), products of the chemical industry worth about 403.0 million Euros (compared to 355.8 million Euros or 7.1% of total imports with an increase of 13.2%), Optical, medical instruments, photographic, musical, etc. in the amount of about 64.8 million Euros (compared to 56.0 million Euros or 1.1% of total imports with an increase of 15.8%).

During this period, there was a decrease in imports in this group: various means of transport in the value of about 409.7 million Euros (compared to 451.4 million Euros or 7.3% of the total imports with a decrease of 9.2%).

Positive trend of import growth from 2012-2022, followed by the following groups of sections: prepared foodstuffs, beverages, alcoholic beverages and tobacco from 311.0 million Euros to 653.1 million Euros, chemical industry products from 185.6 million Euro to 403.0 million Euro, plastic, rubber and articles thereof from 140.3 million Euro to 384.2 million Euro, basic metals and articles thereof from 248.5 million Euro to 593.4 million Euro, etc.

International trade in goods with EU-27 countries

Kosovo's exports to the EU-27 countries reached 311.8 million Euros, or about (33.9%) of the total exports, with an increase of (31.1%). The main partners for the export of goods to the EU are: Germany (9.5%), Italy (5.0%), the Netherlands (3.2%), etc.

According to the chapters, the EU countries have the highest share in the following groups of exports: plastics and their articles, 77.8 million Euros or (25.0%), mineral fuels, mineral oils and their products; bituminous substances; mineral waxes 45.1 million Euro or (14.5%), furniture: beds, mattresses, mattress holders and similar filled layers, lamps and lighting equipment, not included elsewhere 25.2 million Euro, or about (8.1%) , iron and steel articles 24.5 million Euros, or about (7.9%), etc.

EU countries cover most of Kosovo's overall imports.

Kosovo's imports from the EU-27 countries were about 2.4 billion Euros, or (42.4%) of the total imports, with an increase of (15.1%). Imports with the highest share were from: Germany (10.8%), Greece (5.5%), Italy (4.9%), Slovenia (4.3%) and Poland (2.4%), etc.

Imports with the highest participation were in these chapters: mineral fuels, mineral oils and products of their distinction; bituminous substances; mineral waxes where they reached 441.4 million Euros, or about (18.5%), various means of transport where they reached 348.3 million Euros, or about (14.6%), etc.

Trade with CEFT countries

During the year 2022, Kosovo's exports with the CEFT countries reached 333.6 million Euros, or (36.2%) of the total exports, where there was an increase of (19.8%). The main export partners in the CEFT countries are: Macedonia (12.9%), Albania (11.1%), Serbia (6.8%) and Montenegro (4.2%).

According to the chapters, the CEFT countries have the highest participation in the following groups of exports: iron and steel articles, which reached 56.5 million Euros, or about (16.9%), iron and steel, which reached 46.0 million Euro, or about (13.8%), mineral fuels, mineral oils and products of their distinction; bituminous substances; mineral waxes where they reached 28.6 million Euros, or about (8.6%), etc.

Whereas, imports from CEFT countries in 2022 reached 1.0 billion Euros, or (17.7%) of total imports, with an increase of (12.1%). The countries with the highest import share were: Serbia (6.6%), Macedonia (5.0%), Albania (4.5%). Imports with the highest participation were in these chapters: iron and steel, where they reached 174.0 million Euros, or about (17.4%), mineral fuels, mineral oils and their products; bituminous substances; mineral waxes. where they reached 153.0 million Euros, or about (15.3%), Beverages, alcoholic beverages and vinegars, where they reached 76.4 million Euros, or about (7.6%) etc.

Trade with other countries of the world

Kosovo's exports to other countries reached 275.1 million Euros, or (29.9%). The most important partners from these countries for export are: USA (14.8%), Switzerland (7.6%).

While Kosovo's imports with other countries reached 2.2 billion Euros, or (39.9%). The countries with the highest import share in this group were: Turkey (14.9%) and China (9.7%).

## Methodological Explanations

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### Kosovo international trade statistics - methodological notes Resources

Trade statistics consist mainly of documents submitted to the customs authority by importers or exporters (or their agents). This document is a Single Customs Document (SCD), which is used for customs clearance purposes. Information from the document is transferred to the customs information system.

#### Responsibilities for collecting, compiling and release of data

The customs administration is responsible for the collection, entering and processing of customs declaration data. Data in the field of statistics, which are registered in SCD, are reported on a monthly basis by the Customs Administration to KAS, electronically.

KAS is responsible for processing and publishing Kosovo international trade data. These statistics include data according to the type of customs procedures. Additional work involves the correction and approval of customs data.

#### Scope

Kosovo international trade statistics do not include imports and exports of temporary goods which, in the unaltered state or condition, will be returned after a certain time, such as services, repairs, money in terms of wages, money in gold, supply of fuel of Kosovar vehicles abroad, import of goods for liaison offices and other diplomatic missions in Kosovo, personal luggage of passengers, commercial samples and low value mail packages.

#### The registration system

Kosovo international trade statistics are compiled according to the "special" (facilitating definition) system of international trade registration. Under this system, imports and exports are recorded at a time when goods move through the territory under free circulation, and this is the part where goods can be sold without customs restrictions. The mitigating definition implies that in addition to the regular export and import transactions, both external and internal processing is involved

Special exports include exports of goods: exports after inward processing, exports for outward processing and exports that are not registered in customs.

Special imports consist of imports of goods from: imports for inward processing (S.S), imports after external processing, imports that are not registered in the customs

Excluded are goods that are in transit.

#### Estimation

For imports, the cif value (including cost, security and transport of goods at the entry point in Kosovo) is used. The export value is fob (free on board). This is the price of goods purchased abroad including packaging, transport within the country, the charge price, insurance and other costs incurred when the goods are placed on the vessel for export, on airplanes or transported to remote areas. The value of the invoice is recalculated to the value of the Kosovo border by adding or subtracting, in whole or in part, the costs of transport, loading, unloading, which depend on the terms of supply specified in the contract.

The value excludes:

" any amount received by the exporter on the route of reimbursement, reimbursement of the customs duty, subsidy or any other granted.

" any foreign customs duty or modification of the carriage of goods other than at the customs point or at the point of exportation.

The value is in euros. For transactions where the value is denominated in another currency, the euro exchange rate is made using the weekly exchange rate.

Reference period

The calendar month is a basic time to collect the data. Based on customs data, the date of delivery of the customs declaration or other valid dates for the implementation of the customs rules are the time to register the import / export transactions.

#### Quantity units

The quantity of imported and exported goods is shown net weight, if it can be determined, taking into account the nature of the product as well as the additional unit when described by the customs tariff nomenclature.

Net weight is the usual unit of the given quantity. The weight of containers, luggage, bottles and packing materials are excluded.

Other units of quantity used for some of the most important goods such as livestock, motors for vehicles, local equipment, watches, clothes (where the numbering unit is used), shoes (where the number of pairs is used), wrappings for the floor (where the square meter is used) and beverages (where volume is used).

#### Partner states

In this publication, imports are registered by country of origin (as opposed to the country of destination). Goods obtained or produced in a country of origin but from the same country. A product in whose production are involved two or more countries, then as a country of origin is considered the country where the last major processing was made. Packaging, repackaging and classification are not considered as manufacturing processes.

Exports are classified by country of final destination. The last destination of goods is considered the last state for which the goods are intended. This does not mean that it is the country where the goods will be discharged or where the final consumption will be made.

#### Classification of the state

The country nomenclature is the classification of countries (geo-nomenclature), according to the Official Journal of the European Commission, published annually. Since January 1999, the United Nations' ISO alpha 2-digit system is used, where each state is identified by a figure composed of two-letters.

#### Classification of goods

Statistics are collected by using the Combined Nomenclature (CN) 8 digit - tariff and statistical nomenclature of the EU. This nomenclature is managed and updated annually by the Commission in cooperation with Member States. CN is aligned with the 6-digit system of the Harmonized System of Commodity Description and Coding System (HS) - the Nomenclature of the Customs Council for Co-operation that is used throughout the world for applying customs tariffs and compiling international trade statistics. The CN contains about 10,400 sub-head 8-digit number, the first six digits are identical with the figures of the Harmonized System (HS).

The Standard Classification of Trade (SCT), revision No.3 (SSCT Rev 3) has been developed by the United Nations for advanced international comparability of international trade statistics.

Standard Classification of External Trade (SCET) Revision No.3 contains about 3,100 basic headings (5-digit). These are combined into 261 groups (3-digit), 98 divisions (2-digit) and 10 sections (1-digit). For example, Section 6 (manufactured goods classified mainly by material) consists of 9 Divisions, 61 to 69. Division 64 (paper, paperboard and articles thereof) consists of two groups, 641 and 642, which together consist of 72 basic headings, such as 642.94 (paper handkerchiefs, towels, tablecloths, and the like).

SCET Revision No.3 is identical to the structure of the Harmonized System. Each of the categories in the SCET (including all the basic headings) is equivalent to a combination of HS headings (and therefore to a combination of CN headings).

#### Publication of data

Monthly data are provisional and are published 24 days after the reference month.

Annual data are published in June as final data.

## Kosovo Agency of Statistics: short description

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**Kosovo Agency of Statistics** is a professional institution which deals with collection, processing and publication of official statistical data. As such acts since 1948 and has passed through several historical stages, structured according to state regulation of those times.

On 2 August 1999, the Agency has resumed his professional work (after nine years of interruption of all statistical series detrimental to the interest of Kosovo), as an independent institution under the Ministry of Public Administration. Since 12.12.2011 the Agency operates in the frames of the Prime Minister's Office. Office is funded by the Kosovo Consolidated Budget, but also by donors for specific projects and for technical professional support.

**Kosovo Agency of Statistics** acts according to the Law No. 04/L-036 which entered into force on 12.12.2011. Strategic development plan 2018-2022 is being implemented for the development of the statistical system in correlation with the Statistics of the European Community (EUROSTAT).

**Kosovo Agency of Statistics** has this organizational structure: statistics production departments; (Department of Economic statistics and National Accounts, Department of Population statistics, Department of Agriculture and Environment statistics and Department of Social statistics. Support Departments; (Department of Methodology and Information Technology, Department of Administration. Within the Agency we also established Office of the Population Census, Huseholds and Dwellings. Regional Offices; Gjakove, Gjilan, Mitrovica, Peja, Prizren, Pristina and Ferizaj

A total of 156 workers are employed, of them, 115 at the headquarters of the Agency, while 41 at the Regional Offices. KAS has the following qualification structure: 123 with university education, 15 with higher education, while 18 with secondary education.

We have professional and technical cooperation with all ministries of the Government of Kosovo, especially with the Ministry of Economy and Finance, Central Bank of Kosovo, with international institutions, EUROSTAT, International Monetary Fund, World Bank, Sweden's SIDA, DFID, UNFPA, UNDP, UNIVEF, and with the statistical institutions of the countries in the region.

**Kosovo Agency of Statistics** almost completely covers the territory of Kosovo, based on the statistical structure of the enumeration areas as the basic unit and sole in the country from which it gets first hand information. All surveys conducted in the field use the extension of the samples in these enumeration areas but also a statistical methodology according to international recommendations. During the collection of statistical data and reports from reporting entities are involved professionals, technicians, administrators, servants of the country offices, field enumerators from regional offices, etc.

In 2011, the project of Population and Housing Census was successfully conducted, while in 2014, the Agriculture Census was also successfully conducted. The results obtained from these censuses will have an important role for the policy development.

**The mission of the Agency;** to meet the needs of users with qualitative statistical data, objective, in time and space so that users have reliable base to conduct regular analysis in the interest of planning and project development at the municipal and country level. To support government institutions, scientific institutes, research academies, businesses in order to provide proper information for decision-makers and other users in Kosovo.

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
