Foreword

The Kosovo Agency of Statistics (KAS) has started to release data on Kosovo's Import and Export since 2001, but credible data are considered from 2005.

Publication of Kosovo International Trade is based on data from Kosovo Customs Service.

All monthly releases are preliminary data that differ from annual (final) data. This release contains data according to the circulation of goods, statistical procedures, sections of the Standard international trade classification (SITC), sections according to the Harmonized System (HS) and partner countries. The methodology and methods are adapted to integrate and compare the statistics of international trade in goods at the international level.

Imports are presented according to country of origin, while exports according to destination.

Fig. 1: Exports of goods, 2005-2024

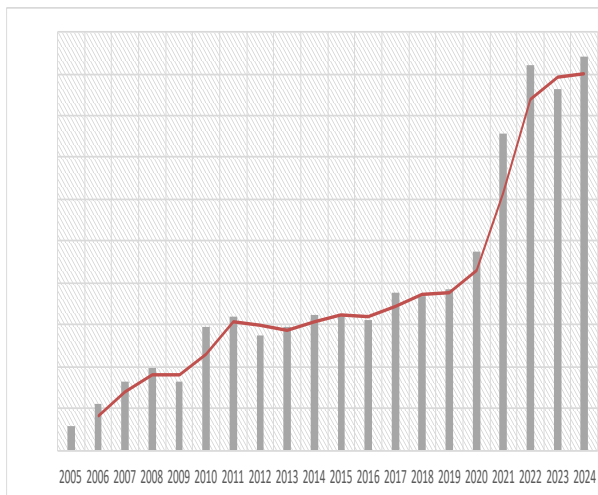


Fig. 2: Imports of goods, 2005-2024

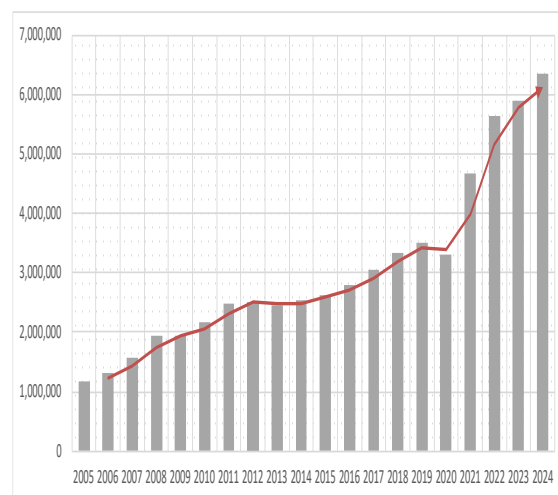

Fig 3: Graphic representation of export by partners in 2024

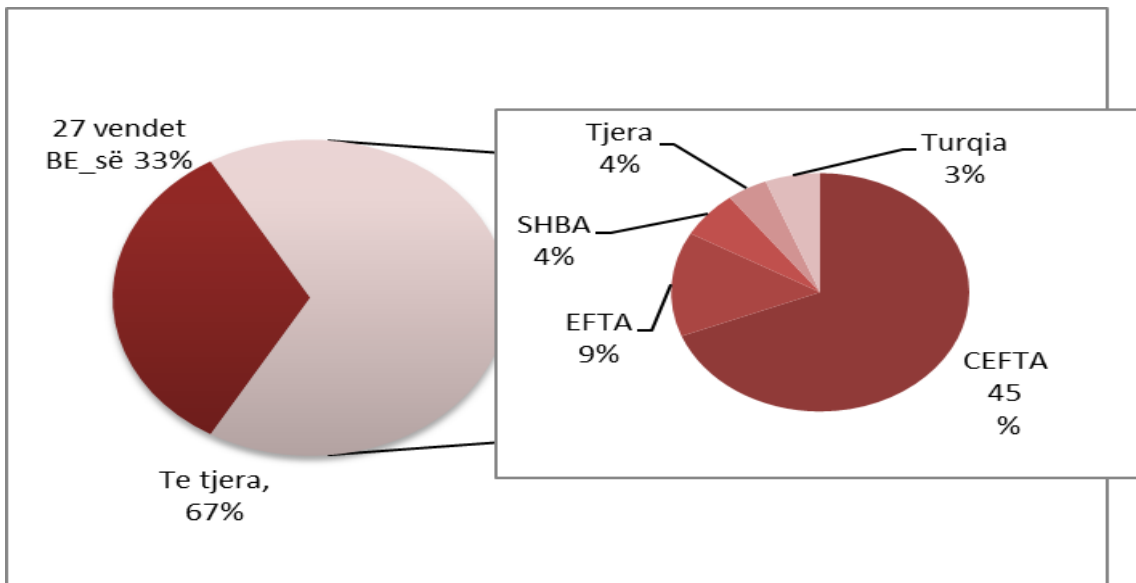


Fig. 4: Graphic representation of import by partners in 2024

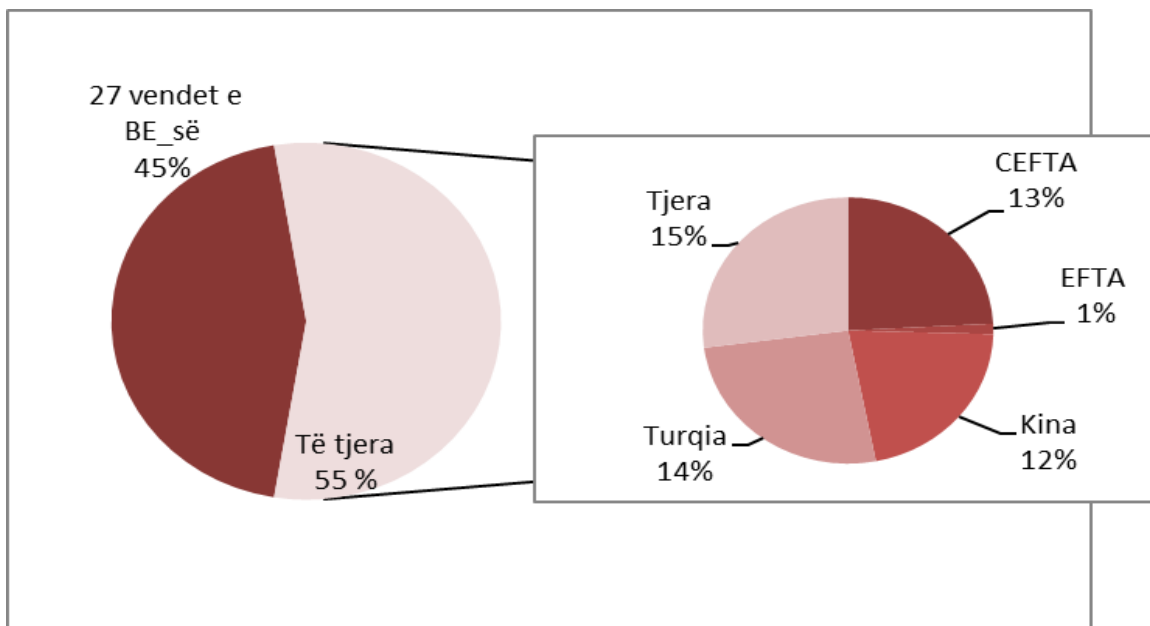

Fig. 5: Exports of plastics and articles thereof

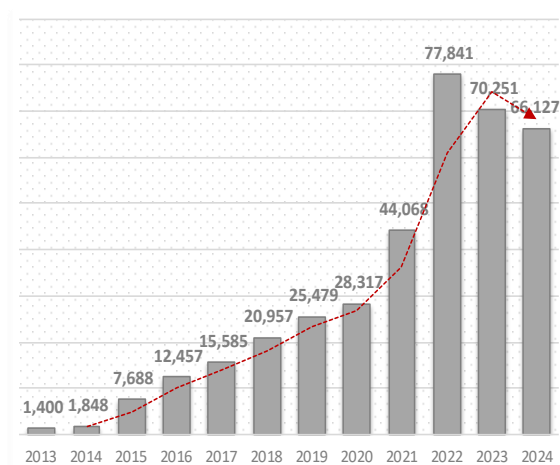


Fig. 6: Exports of iron and steel

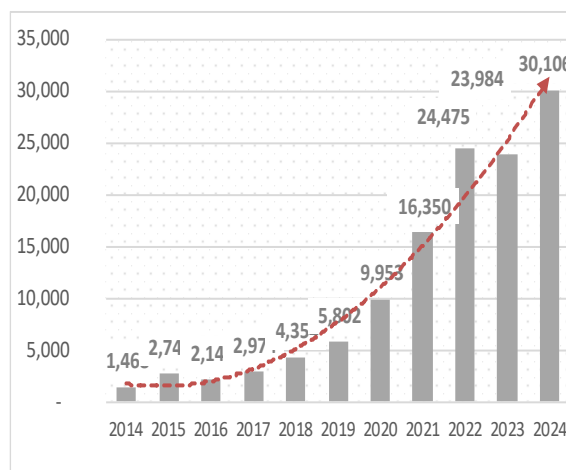


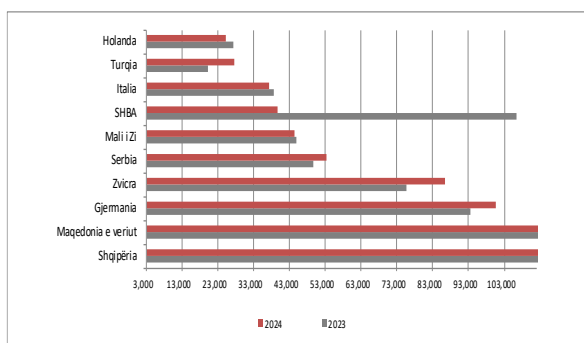
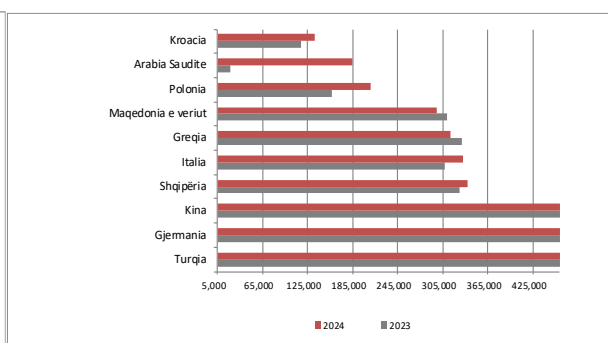

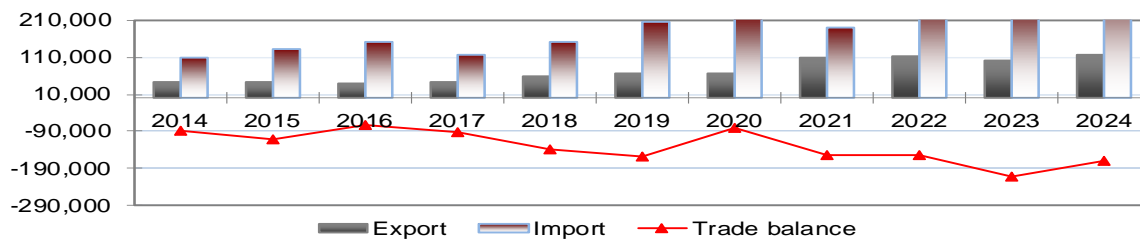

Fig. 11: Graphic presentation with Albania

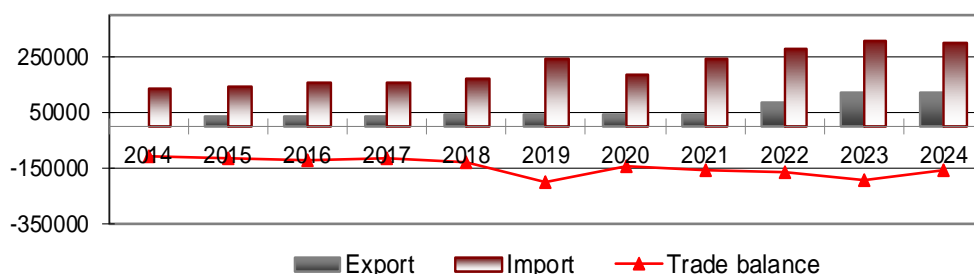

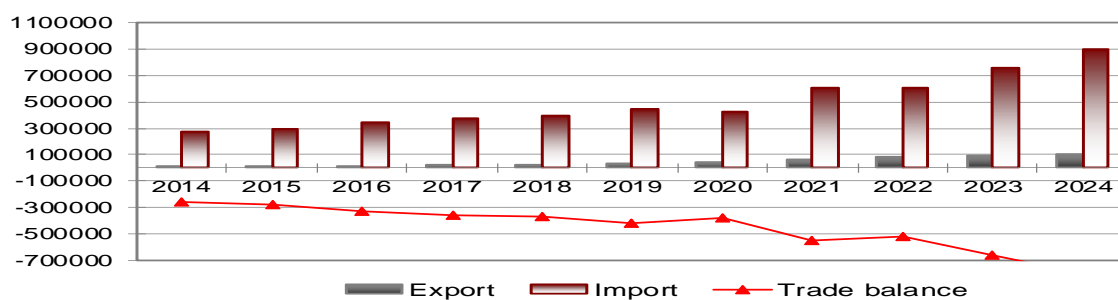

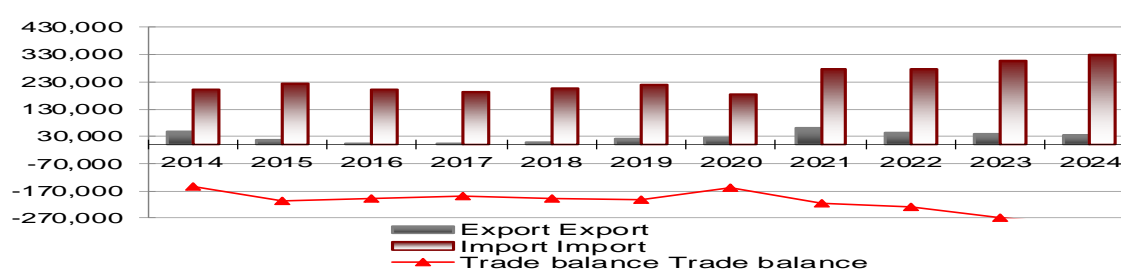

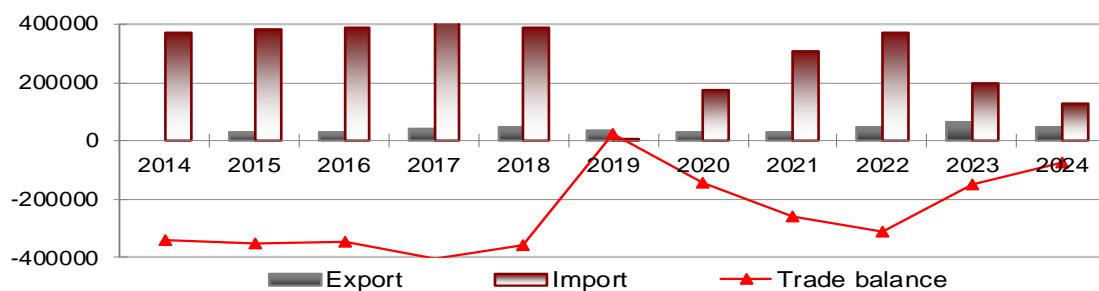

Flow of export and import in 2024

In this publication of statistics trade in goods, many detailed explanations have been given about what our country exports to the foreign market and what it imports from the foreign market.

Trade in goods in 2024 had a trade deficit of 5,4 billion Euros, which indicates a higher trade deficit of 7.4% compared to 2023, where this year we also have a negative balance. Total exports this year were 941,5 million Euros, while imports were 6,4 billion Euros. Exports cover imports by only 14.8%.

Comparing export data for Kosovo goods during 2024 with that of 2023, the figures show that we have an annual growth of 9.1%, an increase which further has Kosovo's negative trade balance.

During this period, there was an increase in exports in the following groups: mineral products worth about 83,1 million Euros (compared to 52,1 million Euros or 8.8% of total exports with an increase of 20.0%), stone articles, plaster, production of ceramics and glass worth around 37,3 million Euros (compared to 31,1 million Euros or 4.0% of total exports with an increase of 59.7%), textiles and textile articles worth around 56,3 million Euros (compared to 41,2 million Euros or 6.0% of total exports with an increase of 36.8%), paper and paper articles worth around 13,8 million Euros (compared to 11,7 million Euros or 1.5% of total exports with an increase of 18.1%), machinery, mechanical and electrical equipment worth around 45,0 million Euros (compared to 35.3 million Euros or 4.8% of total exports with an increase of 27.7%), prepared foods, beverages, alcoholic beverages and tobacco worth around 106.4 million Euros (compared to 90.8 million Euros or 11.3% of total exports with an increase of 17.2%), chemical industry products worth about 30.9 million Euros (compared to 24.6 million Euros or 3.3% of total exports with an increase of 25.6%).

Exports by sections this year had a decrease in the following groups: various manufactured articles worth about 103.7 million Euros (compared to 152.4 million Euros or 11.0% of total exports with a decrease of -31.9%), leather and articles thereof worth about 6.3 million Euros (compared to 6.5 million Euros or 0.7% of total exports with a decrease of -4.1%), optical, medical, photographic, musical instruments, etc. worth about 2.1 million Euros (compared to 2.4 million Euros or 0.2% of total exports with a decrease of -14.7%),

The following groups of sections have had a positive trend of growth in exports from 2014-2024: plant products from 18.5 million Euros to 39.9 million Euros, prepared foods, beverages, alcoholic beverages and tobacco from 20.5 million Euros to 106.4 million Euros, plastics, rubber and articles thereof from 16.3 million Euros to 120.5 million Euros, various manufactured articles from 3,6 million Euros to 103,7 million Euros, etc.

The trade in goods data for 2024 has recorded an annual increase of around (7.7%) compared to the previous year 2023.

Increases in imports by section were observed in the following groups: various means of transport worth around 741,6 million Euros (compared to 591,0 million Euros or 11.6% of total imports with an increase of 25.5%), textiles and textile articles worth around 340,3 million Euros (compared to 316,9 million Euros or 5.3% of total imports with an increase of 7.4%), various manufactured articles worth around 164,3 million Euros (compared to 157,9 million Euros or 2.6% of total imports with an increase of 4.0%), machinery, mechanical and electrical equipment worth around 781,1 million Euros (compared to 676,6 million Euros or 12.3% of total imports with an increase of 15.4%), live animals, products of animal origin worth about 324,9 million Euros (compared to 282,4 million Euros or 5.1% of total imports with an increase of 15.1%), prepared foodstuffs, beverages, alcoholic beverages and tobacco worth about 774,4 million Euros (compared to 718,2 million Euros or 12.2% of total imports with an increase of 7.8%), footwear (footwear and parts of such articles) worth about 68,8 million Euros (compared to 65,9 million Euros or 1.1% of total imports with an increase of 4.4%), chemical industry products worth about 478,1 million Euros (compared to 409,4 million Euros or 7.5% of total imports with an increase of 16.8%), optical, medical, photographic, musical instruments etc. in the amount of about 74,2 million Euros (compared to 67,2 million Euros or 1.2% of total imports with an increase of 10.3%).

During this period, there was a decrease in imports in this group: stone, plaster, ceramic and glass products in the amount of about 187,1 million Euros (compared to 190,5 million Euros or 2.9% of total imports with a decrease of -1.8%), pearls, precious stones, precious metals, etc. in the amount of about 17,8 million Euros (compared to 21,8 million Euros or 0.3% of total imports with a decrease of -18.1%), weapons and ammunition in the amount of about 12,8 million Euros (compared to 112,9 million Euros or 0.2% of total imports with a decrease of -88.6%), etc.

Kosovo international trade in goods with EU-27 countries

Kosovo's exports to the EU-27 countries reached 312,6 million Euros, or about (33.2%) of total exports, with an increase of (12.2%). The main partners for the export of goods to the EU are: Germany (10.7%), Italy (4.0%), the Netherlands (2.7%), etc.

According to the chapters, the highest participation of EU countries in the following export groups is: plastics and articles thereof 66,1 million Euros or (21.2%), furniture: beds, mattresses, mattress supports and similar stuffed mattresses, lamps and lighting equipment, not included elsewhere 39,0 million Euros, or about (12.5%), iron and steel articles 30,1 million Euros, or about (9.6%), beverages, spirits and vinegar 16,9 million Euros or (5.4%), natural or cultured pearls, precious or semi-precious stones, precious metals, jewelry and old coins 13,2 million Euros or (4.2%), etc.

EU countries cover the largest share of Kosovo's total imports.

Kosovo's imports from EU-27 countries were around 2,9 billion Euros, or (44.7%) of total imports, with an increase of (12.1%). The imports with the highest participation were from: Germany (14.2%), Italy (5.2%), Greece (5.0%), Poland (3.3%) and Slovenia (1.9%), etc.

The imports with the highest participation were in the following chapters: various means of transport where they reached 653,8 million Euros or around (22.9%), mineral fuels, mineral oils and products of their differentiation; bituminous substances; mineral waxes where they reached 280.1 million Euros or around (9.8%), etc.

Trade with CEFT countries

During 2024, Kosovo's exports to CEFTA countries reached 426,0 million Euros, or (45.2%) of total exports, with an increase of (24.0%). The main export partners in CEFTA countries are: Albania (18.1%), Macedonia (15.3%), Serbia (5.7%) and Montenegro (4.7%).

According to the chapters, the highest participation from CEFTA countries is in the following export groups: mineral fuels, mineral oils and products of their differentiation; bituminous substances; mineral waxes, which reached 64,7 million Euros, or about (15.2%), iron and steel articles, which reached 55,7 million Euros, or about (13.1%), beverages, alcoholic beverages and vinegar, which reached 46,2 million Euros, or about (10.9%), iron and steel, which reached 32.6 million Euros, or about (7.7%), etc.

Meanwhile, imports from CEFTA countries in 2024 reached 851,9 million Euros, or (13.4%) of total imports, with a decrease of (-8.1%). The countries with the highest share in imports were: Albania (5.3%), Macedonia (4.7%) and Serbia (2.0%). The imports with the highest share were in the following chapters: mineral fuels, mineral oils and products of their differentiation; bituminous substances; mineral waxes where they reached 167,0 million Euros, or about (19.6%), iron and steel where they reached 177,9 million Euros, or about (13.8%), salts, sulfides, oxides, stones, plastering materials, lime and cement, where they reached 72,4 million Euros, or about (8.5%), etc.

Trade with other countries of the world

Kosovo's exports to other countries reached 202,9 million Euros, or (21.6%). The most important export partners of these countries are: Switzerland (9.2%), the USA (4.2%).

While Kosovo's imports to other countries reached 2,7 billion Euros, or (41.9%). The countries with the highest import share in this group were: Turkiye (14.4%) and China (11.9%).

Methodological Explanations

Kosovo international trade statistics - methodological notes
Resources

Trade statistics consist mainly of documents submitted to the customs authority by importers or exporters (or their agents). This document is a Single Customs Document (SCD), which is used for customs clearance purposes. Information from the document is transferred to the customs information system.

Responsibilities for collecting, compiling and release of data

The customs administration is responsible for the collection, entering and processing of customs declaration data. Data in the field of statistics, which are registered in SCD, are reported on a monthly basis by the Customs Administration to KAS, electronically.

KAS is responsible for processing and publishing Kosovo international trade data. These statistics include data according to the type of customs procedures. Additional work involves the correction and approval of customs data.

Scope

Kosovo international trade statistics do not include imports and exports of temporary goods which, in the unaltered state or condition, will be returned after a certain time, such as services, repairs, money in terms of wages, money in gold, supply of fuel of Kosovar vehicles abroad, import of goods for liaison offices and other diplomatic missions in Kosovo, personal luggage of passengers, commercial samples and low value mail packages.

The registration system

Kosovo international trade statistics are compiled according to the "special" (facilitating definition) system of international trade registration. Under this system, imports and exports are recorded at a time when goods move through the territory under free circulation, and this is the part where goods can be sold without customs restrictions. The mitigating definition implies that in addition to the regular export and import transactions, both external and internal processing is involved

Special exports include exports of goods: exports after inward processing, exports for outward processing and exports that are not registered in customs.

Special imports consist of imports of goods from: imports for inward processing (S.S), imports after external processing, imports that are not registered in the customs

Excluded are goods that are in transit.

Estimation

For imports, the cif value (including cost, security and transport of goods at the entry point in Kosovo) is used. The export value is fob (free on board). This is the price of goods purchased abroad including packaging, transport within the country, the charge price, insurance and other costs incurred when the goods are placed on the vessel for export, on airplanes or transported to remote areas. The value of the invoice is recalculated to the value of the Kosovo border by adding or subtracting, in whole or in part, the costs of transport, loading, unloading, which depend on the terms of supply specified in the contract.

The value excludes:

" any amount received by the exporter on the route of reimbursement, reimbursement of the customs duty, subsidy or any other granted.

" any foreign customs duty or modification of the carriage of goods other than at the customs point or at the point of exportation.

The value is in euros. For transactions where the value is denominated in another currency, the euro exchange rate is made using the weekly exchange rate.

Reference period

The calendar month is a basic time to collect the data. Based on customs data, the date of delivery of the customs declaration or other valid dates for the implementation of the customs rules are the time to register the import / export transactions.

Quantity units

The quantity of imported and exported goods is shown net weight, if it can be determined, taking into account the nature of the product as well as the additional unit when described by the customs tariff nomenclature.

Net weight is the usual unit of the given quantity. The weight of containers, luggage, bottles and packing materials are excluded.

Other units of quantity used for some of the most important goods such as livestock, motors for vehicles, local equipment, watches, clothes (where the numbering unit is used), shoes (where the number of pairs is used), wrappings for the floor (where the square meter is used) and beverages (where volume is used).

Partner states

In this publication, imports are registered by country of origin (as opposed to the country of destination). Goods obtained or produced in a country of origin but from the same country. A product in whose production are involved two or more countries, then as a country of origin is considered the country where the last major processing was made. Packaging, repackaging and classification are not considered as manufacturing processes.

Exports are classified by country of final destination. The last destination of goods is considered the last state for which the goods are intended. This does not mean that it is the country where the goods will be discharged or where the final consumption will be made.

Classification of the state

The country nomenclature is the classification of countries (geo-nomenclature), according to the Official Journal of the European Commission, published annually. Since January 1999, the United Nations' ISO alpha 2-digit system is used, where each state is identified by a figure composed of two-letters.

Classification of goods

Statistics are collected by using the Combined Nomenclature (CN) 8 digit - tariff and statistical nomenclature of the EU. This nomenclature is managed and updated annually by the Commission in cooperation with Member States. CN is aligned with the 6-digit system of the Harmonized System of Commodity Description and Coding System (HS) - the Nomenclature of the Customs Council for Co-operation that is used throughout the world for applying customs tariffs and compiling international trade statistics. The CN contains about 10,400 sub-head 8-digit number, the first six digits are identical with the figures of the Harmonized System (HS).

The Standard Classification of Trade (SCT), revision No.3 (SSCT Rev 3) has been developed by the United Nations for advanced international comparability of international trade statistics.

Standard Classification of External Trade (SCET) Revision No.3 contains about 3,100 basic headings (5-digit). These are combined into 261 groups (3-digit), 98 divisions (2-digit) and 10 sections (1-digit). For example, Section 6 (manufactured goods classified mainly by material) consists of 9 Divisions, 61 to 69. Division 64 (paper, paperboard and articles thereof) consists of two groups, 641 and 642, which together consist of 72 basic headings, such as 642.94 (paper handkerchiefs, towels, tablecloths, and the like).

SCET Revision No.3 is identical to the structure of the Harmonized System. Each of the categories in the SCET (including all the basic headings) is equivalent to a combination of HS headings (and therefore to a combination of CN headings).

Publication of data

Monthly data are provisional and are published 24 days after the reference month.

Annual data are published in June as final data.

About the Kosovo Agency of Statistics

Short Description

Brief History - The Kosovo Agency of Statistics (KAS) is a professional and independent institution responsible for collecting, processing, and publishing official statistical data at the national level. Established in 1948, KAS has gone through various phases of development, operating in accordance with the state structures of its time.

After an interruption during the period 1989–1999, KAS resumed its operations on August 2, 1999, as an independent institution within the Ministry of Public Administration. From July 1, 2020, for nearly two full years, it operated under the Ministry of Finance, Labour and Transfers. Currently, it functions under the Office of the Prime Minister of the Republic of Kosovo. The financing of KAS is provided by the Budget of the Republic of Kosovo and by international donors for specific projects and technical assistance.

Legislation - KAS operates under Law No. 04/L-036 on Official Statistics and the relevant amendments through Law No. 06/L-058. The organizational structure includes Production Departments such as: Economic Statistics Department, National Accounts Department, Social Statistics Department, Agriculture and Environment Statistics Department; and Support Departments including the Department of Methodology and Information Technology, the Department for Policy, Planning, Coordination and Communication, the Department of Census and Surveys, and the Administration Department. The Agency also operates Regional Offices in: Pristina, Prizren, Peja, Gjakova, Gjilan, Ferizaj, and Mitrovica.

KAS Mission - To provide high-quality, objective, and reliable statistical data for all users – government institutions, the academic community, the private sector, and the general public – to support decision-making, planning, and policy development at all levels.

KAS Objective - To produce and disseminate statistical data in a systematic, reliable, and impartial manner. This includes professional use and ethical standards, meaning that policies and practices are transparent to both users and survey respondents.

KAS Vision - To be the leading and most reliable source of official statistics in Kosovo, in line with international standards, supporting decision-making, transparency, and sustainable development of the country.

Cooperation - KAS cooperates with all ministries of the Government of Kosovo, especially the Ministry of Finance, Labour and Transfers, as well as the Central Bank of Kosovo, which together form the Statistical System of Kosovo. The Agency also collaborates closely with international organizations such as: EUROSTAT, IMF, World Bank, INSTAT, SIDA, DFID, UNFPA, UNDP, UNICEF, VIIES, IMF, ILO STAT, UNODC, ETF, IA, OECD, and the statistical institutions of the region.

In 2024, the Population, Household and Housing Census in Kosovo was successfully conducted – a key project for the development of sustainable policies.

KAS covers the entire territory of the Republic of Kosovo through a network of reporting units and statistical districts, ensuring primary data collection in accordance with international standards.
